Update on the International Society for Hemodialysis (ISHD)

The ISHD held its annual business meeting the evening of February 21, 2001, at the Morial Convention Center in New Orleans. The first report was of the Council Meeting held October 14, 2000, during the American Society of Nephrology meetings in Toronto. The structure of the Board of Trustees was discussed during the business meeting. There was unanimous agreement that the Board of Trustees will comprise 21 members, and that physicians, nurses, patients, and other health care professionals should be considered for these positions. Six members will be from the United States, one from Canada, one from South America, six from Western Europe, two from Eastern Europe, three from Asia, one from Africa, and one from Australia/New Zealand. A publications committee was appointed to recommend the best offer for an official journal to the president and the Board of Trustees. *Hemodialysis International* was ultimately selected for final negotiations to become the official journal in 2002.
